Loose Parts

Use the chart below to verify that all parts have been shipped.

Description	Qty.	Use
No parts required	_	Remove the blades.
Blades	2	Install the blades.

Removing the Blades

- Disengage the blade-control switch (PTO).
- 2. Shut off the engine, wait for all moving parts to stop, and remove the key before leaving the operating position.
- To access the blades, do one of the following steps:
 - Raise the mower deck to the highest position and raise the front of the machine and support it with jack stands.

Note: Do not rely solely on mechanical or hydraulic jacks for support. Use adequate jack stands or equivalent support.

- Remove the mower deck as described in the Operator's Manual for the machine.
- 4. Hold the blade end using a rag or thickly-padded glove. Remove the blade bolt, curved washer, and blade from the spindle shaft (Figure 1).



Installing the Blades

1. Install the blade onto the spindle shaft (Figure 1).

Important: The sail area (curved part) of the blade must point upward toward the inside of the mower deck to ensure proper cutting.



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- 1. Sail area of blade
- 3. Curved washer

2. Blade

- 4. Blade bolt
- 2. Install the curved washer (cupped side toward the blade) and the blade bolt (Figure 1).
- 3. Torque the blade bolt to 47-88 N·m (35-65 ft-lb).
