Situation

Important Information

On applicable machines (see table above), the Electric Lift Kit actuator switch is wired by design to a constant power source regardless of the key switch position; this is for operator convenience and ease of use.

Consequently, if the key switch is in the OFF position, and the bed lift actuator switch is inadvertently pressed in the down position while the bed is lifted, the bed can be lowered unintentionally.

Corrective Action

If a 12V Electric Bed Lift kit or a 48V Electric Bed Lift kit is installed on a machine within the model and serial number range list above, remove the fuse for the Electric Bed Lift switch when anyone is under the lifted bed, or when the bed is left in the lifted position for a period of time.

This removes the power source to the bed lift actuator switch and keeps the bed from lowering inadvertently. Re-install the fuse once the bed is ready to be lowered to the resting position.

- 1. Park the machine on a level surface.
- 2. Engage the parking brake.
- 3. Shut off the machine and remove the key.
- 4. Remove the associated fuse for the bed lift actuator switch.
