SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Keep this manual in the plastic tube on the spray vehicle or sprayer.

It is very important that all persons operating this equipment have easy access to these instructions at all times!

Carefully read and follow the "SAFETY" "SET-UP" and "OPERATING" Instructions.



The safety alert symbol means **CAUTION**, **WARNING** OR **DANGER** - "personal safety instruction". Read and understand the instruction because it has to do with safety. Failure to comply with the instruction may result in personal injury.

Safety, mechanical and some general information in this manual are emphasized. **DANGER**, **WARNING** and **CAUTION** identify safety messages. Whenever the triangular safety symbol appears, it is followed by a safety message that must be read and understood. For more details concerning safety, read the **SAFETY** Instructions on this page and page 2.

IMPORTANT identifies special mechanical information and **NOTE** identifies general information worthy of special attention. These instructions are provided as a guide for the safe set-up, operation and maintenance of this equipment. However, the operator's personal safety, as well as the persons in the work area, will depend on the careful actions and good judgement of the operator. To reduce the potential for injury or death, comply with the following safety instructions.



SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

BEFORE OPERATING:

1. Operate this machine only after reading and understand the contents of this manual. A replacement manual is available by sending complete model and serial number to:

WHILE OPERATING:

1. Make certain everyone is clear of the machine before starting the engine to move the vehicle.

2. Drive the vehicle safely:

- A. Always SLOW the vehicle when approaching and while making a turn.

- B. Always SLOW the Vehicle when driving in unfamiliar areas or over rough terrain.

- C. Always SLOW the Vehicle when changing direction of travel or preparing to stop.

- D. When turning or driving on slopes, always SLOW the Vehicle, then turn the Vehicle to prevent loss of control and possible upset.

- E. DO NOT make sudden or sharp turns. DO NOT suddenly change direction of travel on an incline, ramp, grade, slope or similar surface.

- F. Always adjust the vehicle speed to allow for existing conditions such as wet or slick surfaces, low visibility, etc.

2. Drive Vehicle slowly.

3. Ensure the Hair Pin is used with Hitch Pin.

- G. Be especially careful when driving a heavily loaded vehicle UP and DOWN the face of the slopes, inclines or grades whenever possible. DO NOT DRIVE across the face if at all possible. There is a risk of upsetting the vehicle.

3. Before backing up, look to the rear and assure no one is behind. Back up slowly.

4. Watch out for traffic when near or crossing roads. Always yield the right of way to pedestrians and other vehicles.


5. Keep all nuts, bolts and other fasteners tightened securely. Replace any shields removed during servicing or adjustments.

6. To assure optimum performance and continued safety of this product, always use genuine TORO replacement parts and accessories. Replacement parts and accessories made by other manufacturers may affect the product's operation, performance or durability. Such use could also void the warranty of The Toro Company.

7. This trailer is to be used exclusively for transporting the 41358 Enclosed Walking Broom.

SET-UP INSTRUCTIONS

Refer to illustrated Parts List for details of parts used in assembling the **ENCLOSED WALKING BOOM TRAILER**.

NOTE: "Right", "Left", "Front" and "Rear" are referenced while standing in the operator's position.

MAIN FRAME ASSEMBLY:

1. Assemble the (2) Wheel Mounts onto the Main Frame using (2) 1/2" x 2" hex hd cap screws and locknuts. The head of the cap screw should be on the side of the tube with the larger hole and when tightened should recess into the hole until it contacts the main frame tube.
2. Assemble Spring Latch onto the Main Frame using (2) 1/4" x 2" hex hd cap screws and locknuts.

TOW HITCH ASSEMBLY

NOTE: There are two alternative mounting positions for the Tow Hitch. The position chosen will depend on the height of the hitch tongue on the tow vehicle. If the Trailer is being towed behind the **ENCLOSED BOOM**, the higher holes should be used. If being towed behind the **MULTI-PRO 1100**, **MULTI-PRO 5500** or **WORKMAN**, equipped with the Universal Hitch included with the **ENCLOSED WALKING BOOM TRAILER**, the lower holes should be used. If the Enclosed Walking Boom Trailer is to be towed behind some other type of vehicle. The hitch height can be determined as follows:

If the tow hitch is less than 14" off the ground the lower holes should be used; If the tow hitch tongue is higher than 14" off the ground the higher holes should be used.

1. Assemble the hitch into the Main Frame using the (2) 3/8" x 2" hex hd cap screws and locknuts.

WHEEL ASSEMBLY:

1. Assemble the (2) Wheels onto Wheel Mounts using a Wheel Bearing Tube, (2) washers, 1/2" x 9" hex hd cap screw and locknut on each side.

UNIVERSAL TOW HITCH MOUNTING

1. On the **MULTI-PRO 1100**, **MULTI-PRO 5500** and **WORKMAN** Spray Systems, without the Enclosed Boom, the Universal Tow Hitch can be mounted to the Main Frame Tube-Welded Assy. (Refer to applicable Parts Manual) using the (2) 3/8" x 1 1/2" Square x 3" U-bolts and (4) 3/8" locknuts.

Refer to the **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS** for proper operating procedures.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

ATTACHING THE ENCLOSED WALKING BOOM TRAILER TO THE TOW VEHICLE:

1. Align the Trailer Tow Hitch with the tow vehicle tow hitch tongue so that the tongue is between the two Tow Hitch pull tabs.
2. Insert the Hitch Pin through the Trailer Tow Hitch tabs and the vehicle tow hitch tongue.
3. Insert the Hair Pin through the Hitch Pin.



CAUTION

Failure to insert the Hair Pin in the Hitch Pin could allow the Trailer to become detached from the tow vehicle and cause personal injury or death

LOADING THE ENCLOSED WALKING BOOM ON THE ENCLOSED WALKING BOOM TRAILER:

1. Ensure that the Boom Extensions on the Enclosed Walking Boom are locked in the Transport Position.
2. Approach the center of the back of the Trailer and insert the front wheel of the Walking Boom into the holder on the Trailer.
3. Push the handle on the Walking boom forward and up so that the detent pins on the Walking Boom Handle Cross Bar align, and insert in, the holes in the horizontal bar on the Trailer, and the latch on the Trailer catches on the Walking Boom fully.




CAUTION

If the Latch does not fully engage, the Walking Boom could release from the Trailer and cause personal injury or death.

MAINTENANCE

The Trailer Wheel Bearings should be greased daily with a No. 2 General Purpose Lithium Base Grease
