Preparing the Machine

No Parts Required

Procedure

- 1. Park the machine on a level surface and disengage the blade control switch.
- 2. Move the motion control levers outward to the park position, stop the engine, remove the key, and wait for all moving parts to stop before leaving the operating position.
- 3. Raise the seat to access the internal components.

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Servicing a machine without allowing sufficient time for the engine and other components to properly cool can result in severe burns and other injuries for you and others around the machine.

Allow the engine the necessary amount of time to cool before performing any maintenance on the machine.


2 Assemble the Cover

Parts needed for this procedure:

1	Engine cover
2	Retainer strap
2	Panel fastener
2	Interlock spacer

Procedure

1. Install the retainer strap to the engine cover as shown in Figure 1. Secure the retainer to the cover using a panel fastener and interlock spacer (Figure 1)



2. Repeat the procedure for the other side.




Installing the Cover Rod

Parts needed for this procedure:

1	Cover rod
2	Bracket
2	Shoulder screw


Procedure

1. Locate the square opening on the interior side of the right hand pod. Insert the end of the cover rod into the square opening at an angle as shown in Figure 2. Make sure the rod is orientated so the bends in the rod face forward to accept the retainer straps.




2. Square opening


2. Pivot the rod down to allow the opposite end to find the slotted opening in the interior side of the left hand pod (Figure 3).



3. Install a bracket on the outside of the upper hole in the pod as shown in Figure 4.

- 4. Install the other bracket on the left side pod at the upper hole as done previously. Secure all parts with a shoulder screw (Figure 5).




- 2. Bracket

4 Installing the Cover


No Parts Required

Procedure

1. Install the engine cover assembly to the rear engine guard as shown in Figure 6. Make sure the tab in the rear of the cover mates with the slot in the guard and pivot the cover forward and down.



2. Pull the retainer straps down and over the forward facing bends in the cover rod (Figure 7) to secure the cover in place.



Maintenance

Removing and Installing the Engine Cover

- 1. To remove the engine cover, pull down and forward on the retaining straps to free them from the cover rod (Figure 7). Lift the cover away.
- 2. To install the engine cover (Figure 6) make sure the tab in the rear of the cover mates with the slot in the guard and pivot the cover forward and down.
- 3. Pull the retainer straps down and over the forward facing bends in the cover rod (Figure 7) to secure the cover in place.

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
