Deck Blades Rotate in the OFF Position

Product: Groundsmaster 3500D February 27, 2009

Groundsmaster 3500D 30821 200000101 - 240000600

Situation:

Replacement parts for Cartridge (104-4877) purchased between November 2004 and November 2008 may have been machined improperly.

Factory assembled components and current inventory of replacement parts are correct; however, replacement parts for Cartridge ASM (104-4877) may have been deficient, resulting in blades that rotate while in the off position.

Instructions:

- 1. Lower the cutting units, turn off machine and remove the key.
- 2. With safety glasses on, stand to the side and far enough behind the machine to observe the blades as an operator in the seat performs the remaining steps:
- 3. Turn the PTO switch to the OFF position.
- 4. Start the engine and operate at full throttle.
- Observe blades:
 - a. If not turning, return the unit to normal service; no further action is required.
 - b. If blades are turning, continue to step 6 (step 9 if repeating steps 1-5).
- 6. Turn off machine and remove the key.
- 7. Adjust the brake valve by turning counterclockwise until screw hits stop.
- 8. Repeat steps 1 through 5.
- 9. If blades continue to turn, replace Cartridge ASM (104-4877).
