
Installation Instructions

Installing the Steering Box Cover

- 1. Stop the machine on a level surface, stop the engine, set the parking brake, and remove the key.
- 2. Open the hood.
- Remove the passenger-side, front fender and save the fender and all fasteners.

Note: You do not need to take the outer and inner fenders apart.

- Locate the steering box opening (Figure 1).
 - If the machine has been driven without a cover over the opening, and the area is wet or dirty, disassemble and clean the steering box thoroughly. Refer to the Service Manual or your Authorized Toro Distributor for assistance.
 - If the machine is new or has only been used in clean, dry conditions, clean the area around the opening (without getting water into the opening).

 - 3. Steering box opening
- 2. Adhesive gasket
- Remove the adhesive backing from one side of the adhesive gasket and adhere the gasket to the flange on the underside of the cover (Figure 1).

- Remove the adhesive backing from the other side of the gasket and adhere the cover to the frame as shown in Figure 1.
- Replace the fender using the fasteners you removed previously.
- Close the hood.
