Adjusting the Cutting Height

Note: The height of cut has changed from a range of 10.2 cm (4 inches) to 2.5 cm (1 inch) to a range of 10.8 cm (4-1/4 inches) to 3.2 cm (1-1/4 inch).

Refer to the Operator's Manual for more information on adjusting the Cutting Height.

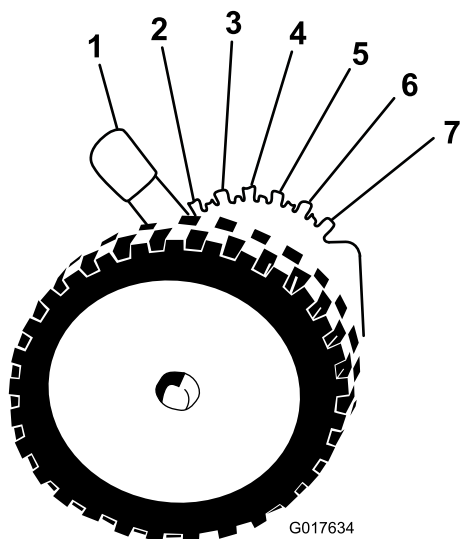

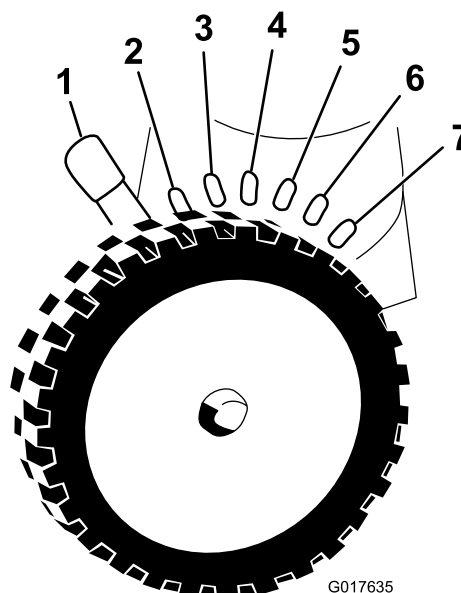
