Affected Units:

All US Kubota Powered Products over 25 hp having diesel engines replaced by new replacement engines.

GM3500G and HDX Electronic Fuel Injected Kubota Gas Powered Products in CA having engines replaced by new replacement engines.

Situation:

Important Information

When replacing engines in US based equipment that no longer comply to current US EPA exhaust emission regulations with a new replacement engine of the same configuration, the EPA requires the old engine to be destroyed so that it does not continue to generate high levels of emissions. Toro and the engine manufacturer are required to track and verify the disposition of ALL such engines being replaced by new, non-compliant service engines. They must also maintain these records for five years.

NOTE: This disposition requirement does not apply to repairs of an engine or replacement with a used or remanufactured engine nor to service

engines sold outside of the US.

Correction: Kubota engines that are replaced by new non-compliant service engines in

Toro Commercial products cannot be rebuilt, sold, or re-used in any way. Parts from the engine can be removed, but the engine cylinder block must be

destroyed.

Destruction of the engine must be documented by your Toro distributor by completing the Kubota form attached to the replacement engine and returning a copy to:

IN ORDER TO ENSURE PROPER PROOF OF ENGINE DESTRUCTION, A CORE CHARGE OF \$1000 IS BEING APPLIED TO AFFECTED NEW SERVICE ENGINES. THIS WILL BE REFUNDED TO THE PURCHASER ONCE THE DISPOSITION FORM HAS BEEN PROPERLY COMPLETED AND RETURNED TO **TORO**.

Action Required:

Report as Required

Engine destruction can be accomplished by punching or drilling a hole in the side of the engine block. The form attached to the new replacement engine must be completed, signed, and returned to Kubota. A picture of a hole in the crankcase and one of the engine serial numbers is requested but is optional. It is preferred that the forms and photos be scanned and emailed to both Toro and Kubota at the same time. In that way, Toro will know that Kubota also has record of the engine destruction. The core charge will not be refunded by Toro until we have received the proof of destruction form.
