- 1. Remove the old self-propel cable and discard it.
- 2. Tip the machine onto its right side (air filter up).
- 3. Locate the bottom end of the rear rivet that holds the model and serial number plate onto the housing (Figure 1).






- 1. Rear rivet end
- 2. Drill a 16 mm (5/8 inch) diameter hole here.


- 4. Mark a spot 25 mm (1 inch) directly below the rivet end (Figure 1).
- 5. Drill and deburr a 16 mm (5/8 inch) diameter hole in the mower housing from below at the spot that you marked in step 4.

**Note:** The oil filter is located directly above the spot where you are drilling. Mark the drill bit with tape 6 mm (1/4 inch) below the tip of the drill bit to indicate at what depth you are to stop drilling.


- 6. Insert the new cable from the top (spring end first) through the drilled hole.
- 7. Attach the cable spring end onto the transmission activation lever as shown in Figure 2.



- 1. Transmission gear case
- 3. Transmission activation lever
- 2. Cable spring end
- 8. Insert the cable anchor into the hole in the bracket on the transmission gear case as shown in Figure 3.



- 1. Cable anchor
- 2. Transmission case
- 9. Route the cable upward along the left side of the handle as shown in Figure 4.



- 1. Cable
- 10. Secure the upper end of the cable to the traction lever.
- 11. Adjust the self-propel cable; refer to Adjusting the Self-propel Cable in the *Operator's Manual*.
