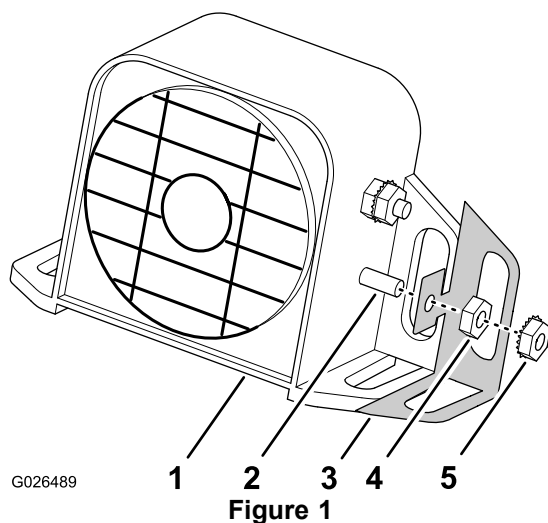
Loose Parts

Use the chart below to verify that all parts have been shipped.

Description	Qty.	Use
Backup alarm	1	Install the kit.
Hex bolt	2	
Nut	2	
Wiring harness	1	
Cable tie	6	

Installing the Kit

1. Park the machine on a level surface, stop the engine, set the parking brake, and remove the key from the ignition.
2. Remove the 2 nuts from the ground stud of the backup alarm (Figure 1).

3. Remove the grounding strap from the stud of the alarm (Figure 1).

Note: Discard the ground strap.

4. Install the plain-terminal nut onto the ground terminal hand tight (Figure 1).
5. Attach the backup alarm to the rear bracket of the machine using the hex bolts and nuts (Figure 2).

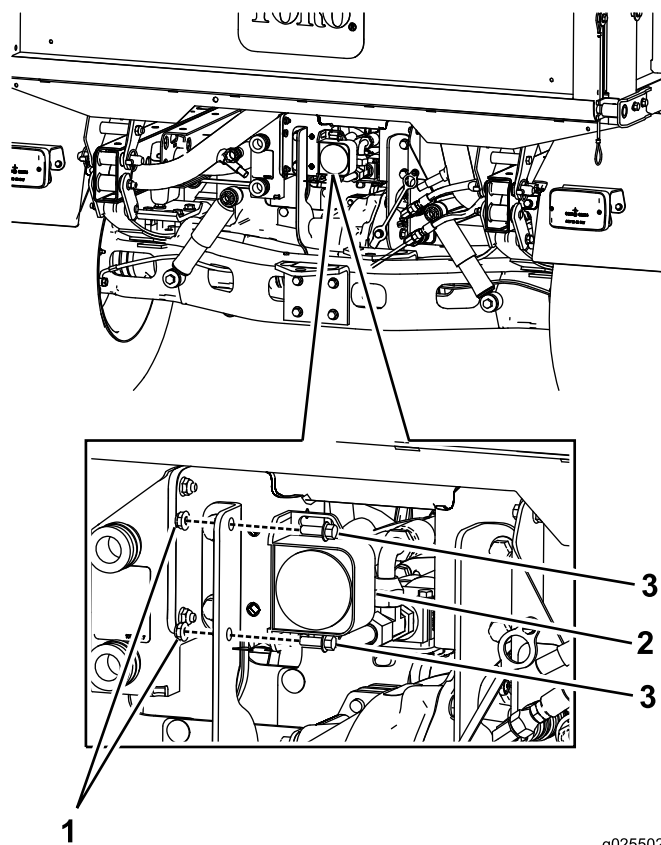

6. Secure the wiring harness to the backup alarm (Figure 3).

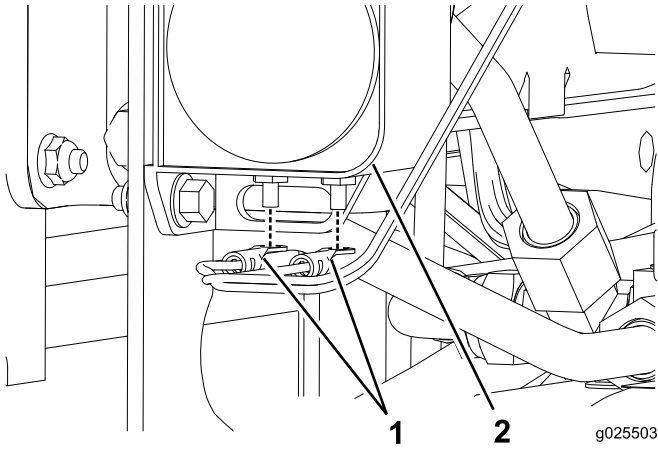

7. Route the wiring harness to the front of the machine by following the other wiring harnesses (Figure 4).

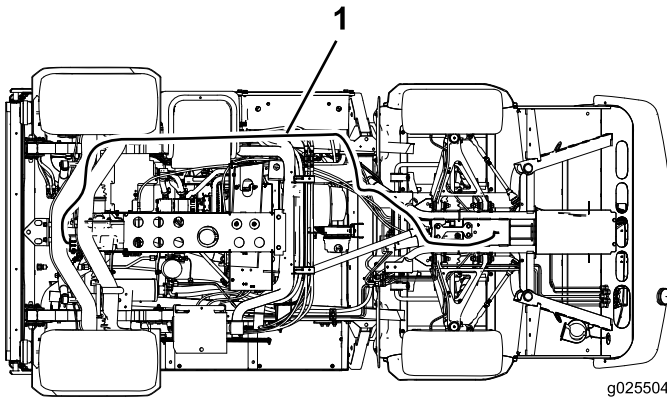

8. Secure the wiring harness with cable ties.
9. Remove the screws and remove the control panel in-between the 2 seats (Figure 5).

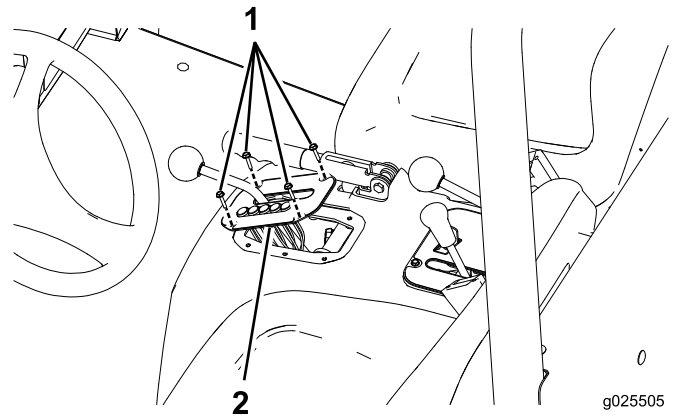

10. Unplug the shift-indicator connector from the vehicle harness (Figure 6).

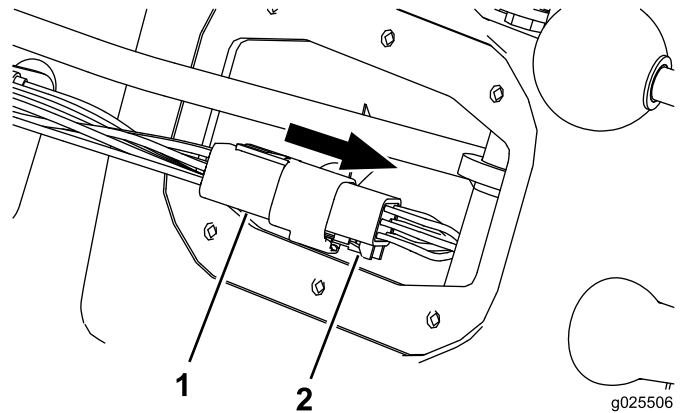

11. Plug the shift-indicator connector to the backup-alarm harness (Figure 7).

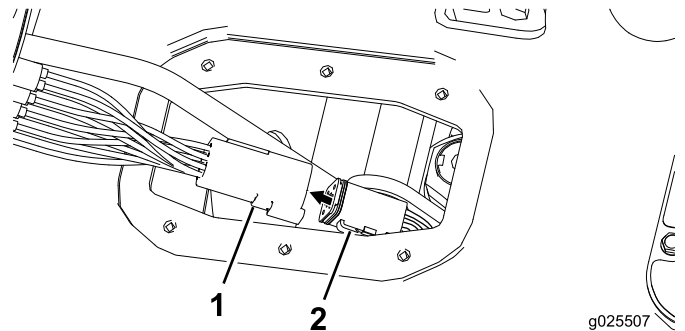

12. Plug in the vehicle connector harness to the backup-alarm harness (Figure 8).

Note: Ensure that the wiring harnesses are not in the way of moving parts.

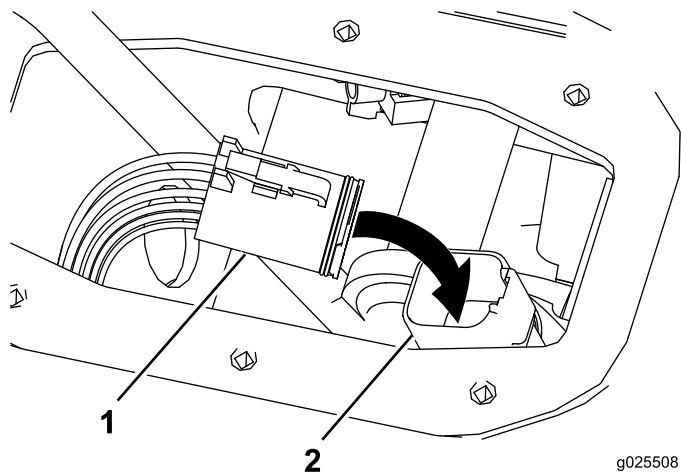
