Front bracket	2	
Carriage bolt	2	Install the front brackets.
Flange nut	2	
Grommet	4	
Flange-head bolt	4	
Washer	8	Install the canopy.
Flange nut	4

Installing the Rear Bracket

1. Park the machine on a level surface.
2. Stop the engine, engage the parking brake, and remove the key from the ignition switch.
3. Loosen the existing 3 flange nuts secured to the 3 carriage bolts on the canopy frame (Figure 1).



4. Position the rear bracket so that the 3 existing carriage bolts fit into the 3 slots in the bracket ([Figure 2](#)).



5. Tighten the flange nuts to secure the bracket.

Installing the Front Brackets

1. Position a front bracket as shown in [Figure 3](#).



1. Carriage bolt (2)
2. Front bracket (2)
3. Flange nut (2)
4. Mounting tab

2. Secure the bracket with a carriage bolt and a flange nut ([Figure 3](#)).
3. Repeat the procedure for the other front bracket.

Installing the Canopy

1. Install a grommet into each of the 4 bolt holes in the canopy ([Figure 4](#)).



2. Grommet

2. Position the canopy as shown in [Figure 5](#).



1. Flange-head bolt (4)
2. Washer (8)
3. Canopy
4. Flange nut (4)

3. Secure the canopy with 4 flange-head bolts, 8 washers, and 4 flange nuts ([Figure 6](#)).


