This document contains an additional procedure to mount the snow deflector in the correct throwing position.

Mounting the Snow Deflector

- 1. Remove the carriage bolts, nuts, and washers securing the snow deflector (Fig. 1).
- 2. Swing the snow deflector back, over the lip of the upper section of the discharge chute (Fig. 1).
- 3. Secure the snow deflector with the carriage bolts (heads to the inside), nuts, and washers removed previously (Fig. 1).

IMPORTANT: Tighten nuts only enough to give friction between the chute and deflector. The deflector must pivot for adjustment.

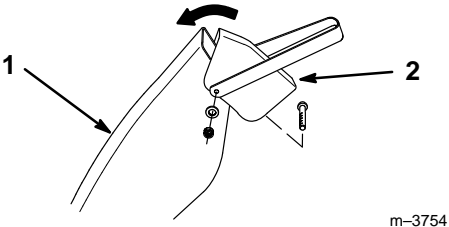

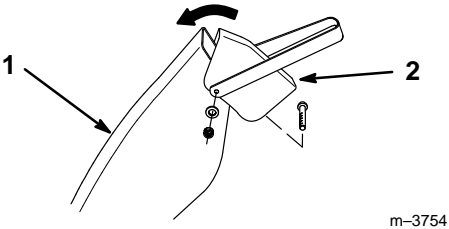
